SURFACE PREPARATION

The surface should be free from dust and all forms of contamination. Remove all loose and flaking paint. Previously painted walls should be thoroughly washed down with Sugar Soap, rinsed with clean water and allowed to dry. Fill cracks and damaged surfaces with suitable fillers. Mood is suitable for application over most conventional fillers. It is suitable for use over surfaces previously painted with alkyd/oil paints. The surface should be lightly sanded with a fine grade of sandpaper, wiped down with a damp, lint-free cloth and then allowed to dry prior to painting. Unpainted surfaces should be primed with a good quality acrylic primer.

REMARKS

- Drying time increases at low temperatures and higher air humidity.
- Mix paint thoroughly before use.
- If you thin the paint with a larger quantity of water than prescribed, the coverage of the product decreases accordingly.
- The final film appearance depends on the surface. A smooth film appearance can be obtained on polished wall surfaces.
- Cleaning of stains etc. can be done with a soft cloth and mild non-abrasive cleaners.
- Prior to use, test the resistance of a coating to the chosen cleaner on a less visible part of the wall surface.
